Arts and culture are interwoven into the very fabric of Bangor. For more than 150 years, theaters, arts, and music have been integral parts of the community. Today, visual artists, filmmakers, musicians, poets, writers, and digital creators live and work in Downtown Bangor and perform and show their works in a wide variety of venues.

MUSEUMS AND ART GALLERIES

Maine's modern and contemporary art museum, the Zillman, frequently displays contemporary works alongside works in its permanent collection, including pieces by Andy Warhol, Pablo Picasso, Andrew Wyeth, Alex Katz, and many others. Exhibits change three times per year, so there's always something new to see.

The monthly First Friday Art Walk features new local works scattered among Downtown galleries and businesses, many of which remain on display until the next Art Walk. See other celebrations of the visual arts at the Bangor Public Library galleries; The Sohns Gallery, located within The Rock & Art Shop; byDESIGN Gallery; and small studios scattered throughout Downtown's many historic buildings.




BEAUTIFICATION

The Downtown Bangor Beautification Committee and other volunteer groups work to make Downtown clean, sustainable, and vibrant year-round. During spring and fall cleanup days, the community gives downtown parks and Kenduskeag Stream Trail extra love. Volunteers in the Adopt-a-Garden program plant and care for more than 150 small gardens and planters in summer. PUBLIC ART

Visible from nearly every corner, public art adorns Downtown Bangor. Bangor's buildings are part of the scene, embellished with multi-story murals inspired by Maine's flora and fauna, historic and legendary figures, and even vintage postcard art. Bronzes, memorials, and historical artifacts are on display in public parks and modern sculptures nestle along the riverwalk. Bangor's iconic Paul Bunyan stands watch over the west end of Main Street. Look up and down for seasonal displays, including the popular Umbrella Sky installation over Cross Street and the beautiful Wabanaki Wildlife ground mural on Hammond Street.





BAR SCENE



THE PENOBSCOT RIVER

The Penobscot River connects us through economy, history, ecology, and culture. The name Penobscot comes from panawahpskek (the place of the white rocks, or where the rocks widen), and is shared with the Indigenous people of the Wabanaki Confederacy residing in Maine known today as the Penobscot Nation. The Penobscot River is an ecosystem providing recreation, sustenance, and spiritual reflection for the Wabanaki – and all who spend time in Bangor.

For many decades, the Penobscot River was renowned for its wild Atlantic salmon, drawing anglers from across the globe. The fish neared extinction in this area, but are coming back as the river has been the focus of one of the nation's most extensive and successful environmental recovery efforts.

Bangor's riverfront marina is a popular spot to dock boats, and the park along the river is a great place to picnic, throw a frisbee, or simply relax.

KENDUSKEAG STREAM TRAIL

Each April, the Kenduskeag Stream Canoe Race draws paddlers across the country to Downtown Bangor to compete in the annual race to the Penobscot. Nestled along the ledges beside the stream is one of the region's hidden gems. This winding trail takes you a

little over two miles along the Kenduskeag Stream, passing by the remains of old sawmills, charming waterfalls, and stately American elm trees. It's an ideal spot for a run or bike. The trail begins on Franklin Street, with the trailhead between the bridge and the Kenduskeag Stream mural.

LOCAL WILDLIFE

While you're out, you might spot a bald eagle soaring over Downtown Bangor – the national bird has made an incredible recovery in recent decades and is now a near-daily visitor to the river. Other regular avian guests include cormorants, wild turkeys, osprey, and turkey vultures.

Rarer sightings include peregrine falcons and goshawks, and on occasion, seals and porpoises have made their way upriver. Bobcats have quietly padded into the city, and turtles can sometimes be seen sunning themselves along the Kenduskeag. And yes – moose and deer have, from time to time, wandered into downtown. Maybe you'll be the lucky one to spot a moose strolling down Main Street!

GET OUTSIDE

Downtown is fortunate to have many places to get close to nature! Whether you're walking the peaceful Bangor Waterfront along the Penobscot or looking for mill ruins along Kenduskeag Stream Trail, there are many hiking -and paddling- options throughout the Bangor region.

At least 5,000 years before European settlers arrived, the ancestors of the Wabanaki—People of the Dawnland—lived here. Complex relations with settlers led to displacement from ancestral lands and culture. Today, Wabanaki cultural centers preserve language, traditions, and history.

First settled in the 1760s, the city was to be incorporated in 1791. Residents chose the name Sunbury and sent Rev. Seth Noble to register it. Legends differ as to why, but when the paperwork was complete, Bangor was the city's name.

In 1779, Bangor was the stage for the Penobscot Expedition, a Revolutionary War naval battle that ended in disaster for American forces. Many ships were sunk and lay hidden for over 150 years until salvaged in the 1950s. Six cannons from that battle now stand proudly downtown.

During the 19th century, Bangor earned the title Lumber Capital of the World. With more than 300 sawmills churning out over 250 million board feet of lumber annually, the city helped build America. Wealthy lumber barons erected grand mansions, many of which still grace the city. By the late 1800s, Bangor had earned the nickname it holds today—the Queen City.

In the mid-1800s, Hannibal Hamlin of Bangor served as the first Vice President under Abraham Lincoln. Bangor soldiers, including the legendary 20th Maine Infantry, fought heroically in the Civil War, famously holding Little Round Top at Gettysburg.

In 1911, a massive fire devastated the city's east side, destroying hundreds of buildings, churches, and public institutions. The area was rebuilt and is now the Great Fire of 1911 Historic District in the National Register, preserving 48 buildings and three parks. It is considered Maine's most significant collection of early 20th-century public and commercial architecture.

The Bangor Historical Society, located at High and Union Streets, safeguards over 250 years of local history. Visitors can see artifacts from Bangor's lumber heyday, Vice President Hamlin's personal effects, and the sword carried by General Joshua Chamberlain at Gettysburg. Their walking tours are an excellent way to discover how Bangor's storied past continues to shape the city.



History

Notable Bangorians include legendary author Stephen King, country music star Dick Curless, pioneering feminist composer Kay Gardiner, former U.S. Secretary of Defense William Cohen, and Senator Susan Collins. And of course, Bangor claims Paul Bunyan—the giant lumberjack of American folklore—as its mythical hometown.

Today, Bangor's neighborhoods, parks, and downtown streets still carry the stories of the generations who built and shaped the city, offering a living history to anyone willing to explore.

SAY IT LIKE YOU LIVE HERE: Bangor is pronounced "Ban-gore," rhyming with "core" or "more." You can show your Bangor bona fides by pronouncing it like the locals.
